# Forward

**W**ith the 10 years in the development field, Southern Resque has been emerging as sanitation, skill training and environment awareness building resource agency where the organization is partnering with CD Blocks, Gram Panchayats and like-minded institutions.

Over the years it has established community connections and gained ability to work with the youth, SHG members and community people through deliberation of quality work and building ownership of their assets created. The govt. functionaries also appreciated our initiatives and ensured of long term association ship.

Southern Resque has identified its areas of operation where it has shown its key strengths in sanitation, skill training for youth and SHG member and environment awareness. The organization has constructed 2669 individual household toilets (IHHTs) in 5 gram panchayats under Kulpi Block by March 2017 and continued mobilization support for toilet usage and proper cleanliness of the toilets for the last 1 year. The organization has supported the block administration to declare Kulpi block as Open Defecation Free area. More than 1000 youth and SHG members got skill capacity building on computer education, tailoring, mobile repairing, embroidery and dress making and community people of targeted villages oriented on climate change.

The organization is gradually progressing towards creating pools of skilled youth, SHG members with rampant income generation. Southern Resque with the support of Vedanta Foundation is successfully generating employments for youth and SHG members. Hopefully in the near future Southern Resque will scale up its initiatives.

# Executive Note from Secretary' Desk



The state of West Bengal, with 60% of its population below 40 years of age, is sitting on a huge growth opportunity as far as workforce is concerned. However, making the most of this workforce would require developing their skills and making them industry-ready. At present, West Bengal lags behind other states in this area. There is a large scope of engaging the private skill providers.

The key challenges identified in meeting between the World Bank with FICCI organized in the year 2012 are lack of affordability of some part of the cost by BPL students, no demand driven skill training, lack of campaign for awareness building, the skill providers face unwillingness on the part of the learners to pay for skill training and preference is given to pay for a certificate or job guarantee after the training. On the other hand the industry or the employers also hire without checking for certification in the skills. One suggested action point for the government was to take up campaigns similar to the ones on HIV.

### **Initiatives of Southern Resque:**

Following SDG 1 and 8, Southern Resque intervened in skill training programme to capacitate skills on computer, candle making, beautician, dress and garments making, tailoring etc for marginalized deprived and poor youth and women. SDGs 1 and 8 refer to no poverty and decent work and economic growth. The organization is trying to dignify the lives of backward women socially as well as economically and guiding aimless youth towards right track through capacity building and subsequent placement in different agencies.

(i) **Skill training on computer and tailoring for SHG members:** Approximately 480 SHG members got capacitation on computer and tailoring under Blocks Kulpi, Magrahat-II, Bishnupur-II, Pathar Pratima, district South 24 Parganas. The course is of 3 months covering 120 hours. The project was supported by SHG & SE department, Govt. of West Bengal.

(ii) **Skill Development for youth on Computer and Banking:** 580 deprived underprivileged youth capacitated on computer education and banking in Block-Kulpi, Pathar Pratima, Budge Budge I and

Kakdip. The course includes Tally (500 hours), DTP, Domestic Data Entry, Hardware (400 Hours) and peripherals. The project is supported by Paschim Banga Society For Skill Development (PBSSD). All the youth presently engaged in different agencies and are self-reliant.

(iii) **Skill Training on Tailoring for rural women:** With the support of Govt of West Bengal, 50 rural women capacitated in tailoring in Kulpi Block under the district of South 24 Parganas. The participants applied their tailoring skills in income generating business and got benefitted which led their family income increase on 50 % basis.

(iv) **Skill Training on Computer for youth:** 20 youth members trained on computer education under Pathar Pratima Block, District-South 24 Parganas and the project was supported by Youth department, Govt of West Bengal.

(v) **Skill Training for Garments and Dress Making:** 60 hardcore poor women trained on garments and dress making under Kulpi Block. After successfully completion of the course they are tugged up with income generating activities. The project was supported by Green Wings Foundation.

(vi) **Skill Training on Tailoring:** 50 adolescent girls capacitated on tailoring of G.P. Kamarchak and Rajarampur, Block-Kulpi. The project was under Kishori Shakti Yojna and support came from Block ICDS department. The trained adolescent girls are going home based tailoring businesses.

# Household Sanitation

The district of South 24 Parganas has been declared as Open Defecation Free (ODF) district following completion of planned sanitation targets. Southern Resque was also an important associate of Kulpi Block to furnish completion of 2669 household toilets and addressing the objectives of SDG 6 which states of clean water and sanitation. The organization focused on social behavior change communication (SBCC) of the targeted beneficiaries so that the ultimate mission of sanitation is met successfully.

## Initiatives of Southern Resque:

With the approval and supervision of Block administration, Southern Resque after completion of 2669 household latrines in Ramkishore GP, Dhola GP, Chandipur GP, Ramnagar Gazipur GP under Kulpi Block made follow up visits and intervened on hygienic behavior of the community people. The organization found several discrepancies as people were following their old habits and defecating on open grounds, latrines turned into godowns and keeping poultry birds. The field workers targeted social behavior change communication through pocket meetings for toilet usage and cleanliness of toilets. Almost an year efforts made the initiatives a true effect as the targeted beneficiaries have understood the importance of toilets and are using the toilets. The beneficiaries even are working as peer educators by influencing the neighbourhood people to use their toilets taking full responsibility to clean it.

Following the key notes made under SDG 6, Southern Resque has taken some initiatives for awaking people on global warming and environmental degradation. Various researches, talks and seminars have been pointing out to the days we would be encountering to in the near future. Amidst all these, researches and reports have been pointing to the increasing degree of vulnerability of women due to climate change. It is time to think and rethink how our actions and attitudes can ensure a safer environment to the women and children of the society. It will give an opportunity for Southern Resque as an NGO to undertake a study as this is a good opportunity to bridge the existing gaps in understanding climate change, its effect on women and mitigation practices to be adopted by the communities in the regions comes under Sundarban police district.

## Initiatives of Southern Resque:

(i) Tree Plantation: With the support of Nehru Yuva Kendra, Diamond Harbour planted saplings during aranya saptaho' in different places of Kulpi Block and made fencing for their safety and security reasons.

(ii) Mass mobilization program organized involving SHG members, community people and youth. A rally was organized as post aranya saptaho event and made people aware on importance of tree plantation in human life and inspired people to develop kitchen gardens in their households.
